The shank is complemented by a two-knuckle bamboo extension, a natural element that adds visual lightness, originality, and an organic touch to the overall design.*

*The pipe is straight, medium-sized, with a clean and well-balanced line that makes it comfortable to hold and pleasant for everyday use. The bowl is generously sized and features a slightly conical drilling, a solution that promotes even combustion and a cool, steady smoke, bringing out the tobacco's characteristics at best.*

*The finish is executed with great precision and is flawless, while the ebonite stem ensures comfort, a soft bite, and long-lasting durability. The result is an elegant, contemporary pipe that combines Danish tradition, German craftsmanship, and natural materials in perfect balance.*
