#### **Ser Jacopo Fiammata Diamond No. 01 (2026) - Bent Dublin Pipe**

*Within the landscape of fine Italian craftsmanship, certain artifacts transcend the vibrant history of the industry to become genuine benchmarks for collectors. This **Ser Jacopo pipe**, piece **Number 01 of the year 2026**, belongs firmly to this rare category. It is an exceptionally hard-to-find piece, distinguished by the "**Brillante**" grading—the absolute highest quality classification established by the Ser Jacopo workshop for briar selection. This*



distinction is reserved for only a very few select pieces in the brand's history.

The famous "**Per aspera ad astra**" stamping engraved on the shank is not merely a brand embellishment here; it encapsulates the very genesis of the pipe: the arduous and meticulous search for a block of briar of such purity and beauty, emerging from the challenges of the raw material to achieve absolute excellence.

#### *Aesthetic Features and Grain Geometry*

The model is developed around a **Bent Dublin** silhouette, masterfully and balancedly reinterpreted by the hands of the Pesaro artisans.

- **The Rarity Grade:** As the "Brillante" classification represents the pinnacle of Ser Jacopo's production quality, the "angel hair" straight grain is exceptionally dense, straight, and regular, rotating a full 360 degrees around the entire surface of the bowl.
- **The Rim:** The top of the bowl is crowned with a fine, compact bark top (natural plateau rim), creating an elegant textural contrast and emphasizing the authenticity of the original block.
- **Proportions:** The walls are thick, ensuring optimal thermal stability during smoking and a rigorous yet sinuous presence.

#### *Technical Specifications and Drilling*

Technical analysis of the artifact reveals Ser Jacopo's customary attention to mechanical functionality, an essential element for the most demanding smokers.

- **Bowl:** Capacious and generous, well-suited for meditative smoking and blends that require space to express themselves fully.
- **Drilling:** Executed with precise cylindrical geometry, tapering slightly towards the bottom to optimize tobacco combustion and facilitate an even draw down to the very last strand.
- **Stem:** Crafted from high-quality black acrylic, it features a saddle design and terminates in a subtle fishtail shape, engineered to provide superior palate comfort and excellent airflow distribution.
