Radice Rind Pipe - Straight Pear with Natural Rim (Year 2026)

The **Rind** line from the artisan workshop **Radice**, entirely handmade in the Cucciago studio, is distinguished by its deep, tactile rustication, meticulously crafted to ensure excellent heat dissipation and a secure grip. This specific model reinterprets the



classic **straight Pear shape in a medium size.**

- **Brand:** Radice (Handmade in Cucciago, Italy)
- **Model:** Straight Pear (Medium size)
- **Finish:** Rind (Black rusticated body, smooth natural rim)
- **Chamber:** Medium/large capacity with a slightly conical drilling
- **Stem:** Standard tapered type in black acrylic

Design Details and Color Contrasts

The aesthetic impact of this piece relies on the striking contrast between the different treatments of the briar:

- **The Rim Contrast:** While the bowl and shank feature a deep, black-stained rustication, the **flat rim (the top of the bowl) is left completely smooth and in a natural finish.** This color contrast highlights the clean grain of the underlying briar and elegantly frames the opening of the tobacco chamber.
- **Chamber Engineering:** The medium-to-large capacity chamber features a **slightly conical drilling.** This technical choice accommodates the natural progression of the tobacco's burn, ensuring a consistent and balanced flavor delivery throughout the smoke.

Dating: The "46" Stamp

- **The Number 46:** The Radice workshop uses an annual numerical progression that counts up from the brand's founding year in 1980.
- **Recent Production:** The **46** stamp uniquely certifies that this pipe belongs to the most recent **2026** production, marking the 46th year of activity for the Lombard workshop.

Every Radice Rind pipe is a unique piece that embodies over forty years of history and evolution in Italian pipemaking technique.
