Francesco Ganci Handmade Pipe - Semi-Rusticated bent Freehand

The **handmade pipe by Francesco Ganci** represents a high expression of Italian pipe craftsmanship, rooted in the historic territory of Liguria. Francesco Ganci is an artisan highly esteemed for his ability to follow the natural lines of the briar, creating unique pieces that blend technical rigor and expressive freedom. Each of his creations is a one-of-a-kind piece, the result of entirely manual workmanship that enhances the structural and grain qualities of the



raw material.

Design, Geometry, and Material Contrasts

This specific model stands out for its sinuous lines and a skillful contrast between textured surfaces and smooth inserts, designed for those who appreciate pipes with strong personality and substantial proportions.

- **Shape and Dimensions:** This is a bent **freehand (shape-free)** pipe with generous dimensions. The silhouette follows an ergonomic curvature that perfectly distributes the weight.
- **Semi-Rusticated Finish and Contrasts:** The bowl of the pipe is characterized by a semi-rusticated finish, which offers an excellent tactile texture and a deep, material appearance. In a refined contrast, the **rim** (the top of the bowl) features an **easy load** treatment left completely smooth, a choice that facilitates the loading of tobacco. The base of the bowl and the bottom section of the shank are also left smooth, showcasing the natural grain of the briar.
- **Handcrafted Stem:** The stem is **handmade from black ebonite**, the traditional material preferred by experienced smokers for its softness under the teeth. The shaping ends with a **fishtail** profile, optimized to ensure a well-distributed smoke flow on the palate.
- **Bowl and Drilling:** The bowl is decidedly spacious, ideal for prolonged and evolving smoking sessions. The internal drilling has been executed to be **slightly conical at the bottom**, a fundamental technical feature to favor a complete combustion of the pack and proper management of residual moisture.
