The design unfolds along a **half-bent** silhouette, offering a free interpretation of the classic **Brandy** shape.

- **The Bowl and Chamber:** Despite the overall dimensions of the pipe being a medium standard, the bowl is deliberately



generous and imposing. This structural choice allows it to accommodate a high-capacity chamber. The thick walls guarantee optimal thermal insulation, while the internal drilling is executed with precision, narrowing with a slight taper at the bottom.

- **The Sandblasting and Ring Grain:** The finish is the true aesthetic centerpiece of this specimen. A fine, deep sandblasting highlights the dense grain of the briar, emphasizing a **ring grain** pattern that wraps around the entire surface of the bowl, providing a high-value three-dimensional texture to the touch.
- **The Stem:** The shank connects to an elegant **saddle stem in black acrylic**. The saddle design lightens the chromatic and structural transition, finishing in a **fishtail** lip. Prominently featured on the stem is the unmistakable duck head application, the brand's seal of authenticity.
