Ashton Pebble Grain XX Canadian - English Handmade Pipe

The **Ashton Pebble Grain XX** is an English handmade pipe that combines the traditional aesthetics of classic British pipe making with the distinctive character of Ashton craftsmanship. This medium-sized pipe is shaped as a **Canadian**, a form traditionally recognized for its elongated shank and elegant, streamlined proportions.



The bowl features Ashton's characteristic **Pebble Grain** finish, a deep and pronounced sandblast that gives the briar a strongly tactile surface. The depth of the blast emphasizes the natural structure of the briar while maintaining the restrained, traditional appearance associated with classic English pipes.

A substantial **silver accent ring** provides a refined transition between the briar shank and the stem. Its generous proportions give the pipe a distinctive visual presence while remaining consistent with the balanced geometry of the Canadian shape.

The **short, tapered stem** is made of **ebonite** and features a traditional **standard button**. Its compact proportions complement the elongated shank and maintain the characteristic balance of the Canadian form.

The **medium-capacity chamber** is drilled with a **slightly tapered profile towards the bottom**, following a practical and traditional approach to chamber construction.

Overall, this Ashton represents a particularly faithful interpretation of the **classic English pipe-making tradition**. Its deep Pebble Grain sandblast, substantial silver accent, compact ebonite stem and well-proportioned Canadian shape create a pipe in which material, craftsmanship and traditional design are closely integrated.

Founded in London in **1983 by William "Bill" Taylor**, after more than two decades of experience at Dunhill, Ashton became known for combining classic English pipe shapes with distinctive technical and finishing approaches. Among its best-known finishes is **Pebble Grain**, characterized by a deep sandblast that enhances the natural structure of the briar.

The Ashton tradition has continued through the work of **Jimmy Craig**, who worked closely with Bill Taylor and preserved the traditional methods and aesthetic principles associated with the brand.
