Dunhill The White Spot Ring Grain 5406 - 2026

English Dunhill The White Spot pipe, shape 5406, belonging to the rare **Ring Grain** series and made in **2026**, as indicated by the **26** stamping. A classically styled model featuring a **semi-bent Pot** shape, medium dimensions, and a particularly uniform and delicate sandblast.

Introduced in **1996**, the Ring Grain finish is reserved for pipes with a pronounced flame grain that are subsequently sandblasted. This



process highlights the structure of the briar through controlled surface etching, creating a more defined texture than a smooth finish while preserving a balanced reading of the wood's natural lines.

Within the Ring Grain production, various colorations exist. Versions featuring tones similar to those of Cumberland are designated as **Shilling**.

The **5406** shape interprets a medium-sized **semi-bent Pot**. It offers a traditional design with a chamber well-proportioned relative to the overall length and a line that maintains the classic balance typical of traditional English shapes.

The **black ebonite stem** is **tapered**, featuring a conical profile and a **slightly fishtail** bit. The stem-shank pairing maintains a clean, restrained line consistent with the Pot shape, free of extraneous elements.

The medium-capacity **chamber is cylindrically drilled** with regular internal geometry. The **homogeneous, delicate sandblasting** is one of the most distinctive features of this piece: the finely worked surface exhibits an even texture that follows the grain structure without being excessively deep.

The **26 stamping** identifies it as a 2026 production, placing it within Dunhill's contemporary output. The combination of the 5406 shape, Ring Grain finish, Pot form, and semi-bent orientation brings together elements deeply rooted in the brand's heritage.

A contemporary take on one of the classic English pipe shapes: **understated, recognizable, and anchored in a long-standing manufacturing tradition**, reflecting a timeless aesthetic identity.
