Dunhill The White Spot Bruyere 2101 - 2026

English Dunhill The White Spot pipe, shape 2101, featuring a **Bruyere** finish and made in **2026**, as certified by the **26**stamping. A **small-sized** model in a **straight Apple** shape, characterized by compact proportions and a design closely tied to the tradition of classic Dunhill pipes.

The **Bruyere** finish holds a significant place in the brand's history. When Alfred Dunhill began transitioning to direct pipe



manufacturing, after having also retailed pipes sourced from France, he observed several practical and aesthetic limitations in the heavy varnishes common at the time. Starting in **1910**, with the launch of partially autonomous production, Dunhill adopted a different approach by developing a lighter, more effective finish called **Bruyere**, the French term for briar.

The core concept behind the Bruyere finish is to **enhance the briar's natural grain without relying on heavy varnishing**. The surface is treated with a mahogany-toned stain designed to accent and complement the wood's natural figure, followed by light waxing. The result is an understated finish where the structure of the briar remains clearly visible and an integral part of the pipe's overall appearance.

The **2101 shape** is a small-sized **straight Apple**. The rounded, compact bowl of the Apple is kept within tight proportions, while the balance between the bowl, shank, and stem gives the pipe a well-proportioned structure.

The **black ebonite stem** is **tapered**, gradually narrowing toward the bit, which features a **slightly fishtail button**. Ebonite, traditionally associated with high-quality stem production, integrates seamlessly into the pipe's classic orientation.

The **medium-to-small capacity chamber is cylindrically drilled**. The compact internal dimensions align with the overall scale of the model and the neat construction of the Apple shape.

The **26 stamping** identifies this piece as part of the **2026** production. The combination of the Apple shape, small size, Bruyere finish, and ebonite stem offers an essential and instantly recognizable layout true to the Dunhill heritage.

A classic, compact model in which the **Bruyere finish** acts as a foundational element of the pipe's aesthetic identity, highlighting the briar through refined workmanship while allowing the Apple shape to define its character.
